

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS Can I Supply my Own Fabric?



Lewis's is a Furnishing Fabrics Retailer. We have a number of suppliers that we have developed strong relationships with and are confident in the fabrics that they supply. Using your own fabric can lead to issues around warrantees, fabric suitability and fabric quality. Below is our policy for working with your own fabric:

Making your Whole Order with your Own Fabric

Unfortunately, this is not a service that Lewis's offers.

Making a Small Portion of your Order with your Own Fabric

Lewis's will consider using your own fabric for a small portion of your order, on a case by case basis. If Lewis's agree, you will be required to accept full responsibility for the condition and performance of the fabric. No warrantee will be offered on this portion of the order and all "used" fabric must be laundered prior to being delivered to our Workroom.

Making Alterations to your Curtains

Lewis's can only make alterations to curtains originally made by Lewis's. Curtains must be laundered prior to being delivered to our Workroom. You will be required to cover the cost of a measure service, if needed.

Making Alterations to your Blinds

It is extremely rare that Roman Blinds can be altered. Please discuss your requirements with our staff.

Making New Blinds from your Old Blinds

Blind making is a very precise, time consuming, and expensive operation. Blinds need to be made with new fabrics to get the best result and to ensure the longevity of the finished product.
